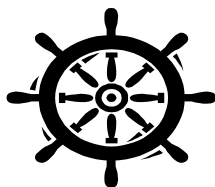

Board minutes for April 2010

Program packets for the instruction at the Oxford Methodist Church were provided to the chapter presidents. The first presenter will be Doreen Hunter who will be making a table runner on April 6, 2010 (about a 4.5 hour class). On May 4 Mary Sharer will teach machine appliqué techniques. A needs list will be available and thread options will also be discussed. Mary asks that in order to take this class one be very familiar with their machine. Beth Bender will be teaching beginner quilting for the first four weeks in June. After paying for the instructor and room rental, the remaining funds will go to the program committee. A class may be repeated if there is enough interest. Each teacher must provide a color picture along with their supply list to each chapter.

Diana McClurg will hold a trunk show for the next evening guild meeting. Linda Cantrell will give a lecture for the May 4th guild meeting.

Standing Rules:

- A) Paying members who lecture or teach from the chapters is permissible.
- B) A presenter who is within a fifty mile radius may be obtained as long as an officer gets them a guest pass.
- C) Sea Breeze chapter had a their first meeting with twelve members. A motion was made and passed that the fledgling chapters get an equal portion of quilt show profits.
- D) It is permissible to swap a meeting room or extend hours up to four times a year as long as there is no conflict. The months of November and December are the exceptions.
