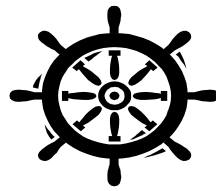

### **Demo committee Joyce Mc Kee Tuesday, March 19th**

Kay Pallas will be conducting a workshop on a Casserole Carrier.

Supplies needed:

Two coordinating fabrics 23x27

Piece of Insul-bright 23x27 ( Insul-bright is available at JoAnn's along the back wall opposite the cutting table. It looks like bits of foil are woven in batting and will help retain the heat of the casserole.)

Two 3" rings which Kay has purchased in bulk as they are hard to find. You can pay her for them at her cost.

Sewing Machine and regular sewing supplies (scissors, pins, thread, etc.)

This size will accommodate an 8" casserole.

We voted on our second project at the February business meeting. We will be making 12 quilts for the Adult group home in Leesburg. Beth has gotten us the size of their beds and specifics about their favorite interests, colors and needs. So far 9 people have been matched up with our quilters. There are 3 who need a match. Here are the specifics on those three people:

1. Ulyses "UB" 64 yrs old  
Twin Bed room is painted blue  
Likes: money, Church goer
2. Stephanie 25 yrs old  
Twin Bed room is blue  
Likes: Radio, music
3. Lynette 50 yrs old uses a w/c  
Likes: Uno, Bingo

Remember ladies that you may work in groups for this project and the quilts may be finished anytime during the year. Also, Nancy W. says she will embroider their names on a pillowcase should you elect to do one to match up with a quilt. If you get the strip ( 12 inch strip that will make a 6 inch cuff )to her before you make the pillow case the name will be on the outside, if the case is completed it will be on the inside. There will be a sign up sheet for this project for the next few weeks.

We are still accepting quilts for the SAFE-T project. Thank you Sandy and Nancy O. We are now up to 51 quilts given to that program. WOW! Very impressive. We are so generous with our time and talents. Thank you!
