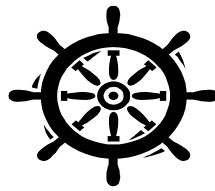

### **May 21st Workshop**

Cut and Shuffle Placemat Set of 4

- Four different Fat Quarters (using different hues with light to dark works well)
- One yard of coordinating fabric for the backing (or, use 4 different FQs to back the placemats)
- One yard of thin batting
- Optional – ½ yard for binding. Or, finish without binding by using the pillowcase method.
- Rotary cutter with SHARP blade as you will be cutting through 4 layers
- Cutting mat large enough that you don't have to move the FQs as you are cutting them
- Scissors, rulers (6x24 and large square ruler), sewing machine, coordinating thread for your fabric, flat head pins and seam ripper (only if you make mistakes) , personal iron and mat if you have one.

The set of placements is assembled in Two stages: 1.) cutting and assembling the horizontal strips; and 2.) cutting and assembling the vertical strips. It will be important that we all do the steps together so please come with your FQs pressed and ready to cut. Using a little spray starch will help.

If you are a snowbird and will not be here May 21st, we will repeat this project in the fall if there is interest.

Upcoming:

June 12th Bev Jahn will demo two methods of doing Pacific Rim applique patterns. If there is sufficient interest, she will do a workshop at a later date.

The cost for attending the retreat is as follows:

**\$154 for a double room:**

- Balance of \$100 due no later than December 6, 2013

Additionally due at the time of registration is \$15 cash to cover expenses, e.g.: materials, project kits, instructors' fees, prizes, photocopying, etc.
