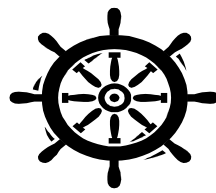

Paducah Bus Trip -

We are planning a bus trip with Sew Great Tours to the AQS Quilt Show in Paducah KY the week of April 21, 2014. This will be a 4 night, 5 day trip including 1 overnight in TN on the way up, 2 nights in Paducah and 1 night in TN on the back. We will also stop at a quilt shop on the way up. The Retreat Committee is in the initial planning stages of our fifth annual quilting retreat that will take place at the Lake Yale Baptist Conference Center in Leesburg, FL on :

Tuesday, February 25th through Thursday, February 27th, 2014

The cost for attending the retreat is as follows:

\$154 for a double room:

- Deposit of \$84 due at time of registration
- Balance of \$70 due no later than December 6, 2013

\$204 for a private room:

- Deposit of \$104 due at time of registration
- Balance of \$100 due no later than December 6, 2013

Additionally due at the time of registration is \$15 cash to cover expenses, e.g.: materials, project kits, instructors' fees, prizes, photocopying, etc.
