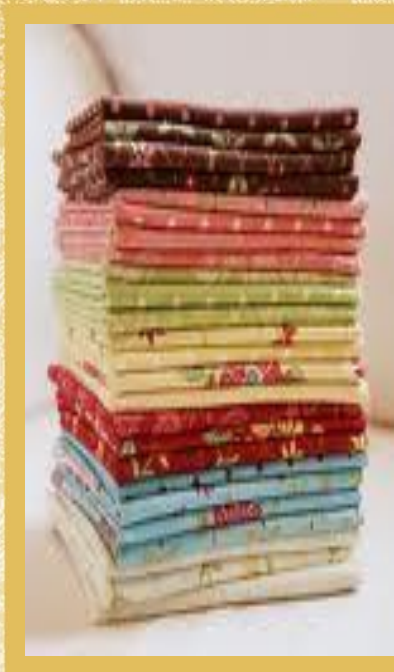


CHATHAM CHATTER
