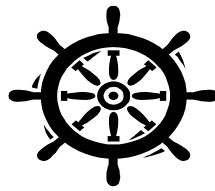

Reminder, if you have an outstanding balance, it is due on or before November 19th. Checks are to be made payable to *Lake Miona Quilters* and given to Beth Dombeck.

Demo for October

Our next demo is planned for October 8th when Sandy Plunkard will do a workshop on a Christmas table runner using a half hex ruler. Demo/Workshop for October 8th

Sandy Plunkard will be conducting a workshop October 8th for a Half Hex Christmas Table Runner With Center Star. Sandy has had samples of this project at our recent meetings. It's easy, quick and turns out very nice! The materials you will need are listed.

. Large Half Hex ruler. If you do not have one, Sandy will be supplying templates so you do not need to purchase the ruler.

. 10" minimum cut (by width of fabric) of green printed fabric for the tree. The tree can be all the same green or you can use different green prints. If you decide to use different prints, one branch requires a piece of fabric 5" x 10". You will need either 6 or 8 branches depending on how large you want your table runner. Sandy made one with 6 branches using 3 different green fabrics.

. 14" minimum cut (by width of fabric) of background fabric. Light in color, white or off-white.

. 9" square of fabric for the star (gold or red, your preference). Sandy will provide the template for the star.

. Heat and bond or wonder under for the star

. 12" of border fabric

. backing, batting and binding

If you make the runner with 6 branches, the size will be 33x19

If you make the runner with 8 branches, the size will be 41x19

. Sewing machine, scissors, pins, rotary cutter and mat, thread to match your fabrics.

Please sign up so we will know how many templates are required. Joyce McKee has the sign-up sheet. We already have 15 participants!
