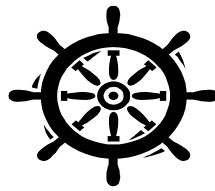

Demo for November 12th

Bindings and Infinity Scarf

Kay Pallas will show us how to construct a self-mitered binding. This technique can be used on quilts, place-mats, pot holders or anywhere you would like mitered corners on your sewn project.

Joyce M. will show how to make binding using one color fabric for the binding on the front of the quilt and a different color fabric for the binding on the back of the quilt. This method works well on quilt-as-you-go projects since often the front and back of these quilts are quite different.

Beth Dombeck will show us how to make an infinity scarf. These are popular accessories for fall and would be a great gift to make for someone on your shopping list. If there is interest, we can have a workshop and make the infinity scarf.
