

QUILT CHALLENGE RULES 2015

Challenge: Make a wall hanging with your interpretation of the theme “**Quilting in Paradise**”.

It must incorporate a minimum of half of the provided piece of fabric and must be visible on the front side of challenge. Also must include a polka dot fabric and a stripe fabric on the front side of the quilted wall hanging as well.

It must be a quilted challenge. No dioramas.

The total outer dimension must be a minimum of 70 inches, but not more than 120 inches. This allows for any design you wish for for your wall hanging.

The wall hanging must be made by the person entering the challenge, this includes the quilting. The back will be judged as well.

1. You may hand piece, machine piece or paper piece.
2. You may applique by hand or machine.
3. You may embellish as you wish.
4. You may machine or hand quilt.

Wall hangings which do not meet the criteria will not be put forward for judging.

Add a small fabric label with your name, address and phone number and sew it onto the right hand lower edge of the quilt back.

Entry fee to the challenge will be \$5.00. This will be refunded when you turn in your completed wall hanging to the Challenge Committee. Only one entry per person will be accepted. Completed Challenges will be dropped off January 8, 2015 at Laurel Manor for judging.
