

Showcase of Quilts 2015

Categories

Wearables

300 The articles of clothing must be 50% quilted. This means that there must be a top, batting and backing in the quilted areas.

Challenge Quilts

500 Quilts are to be created based on the criteria established by the committee handling this category. Details for this category will be provided by the committee at future Guild meetings and posted on the Guild's web site. If you have questions, please email QGOTV.SC2015@gmail.com.

Rookie

900 This quilt can be any technique, machine or hand done, but it must be done by a quilter with two (2) years or less of quilting experience.

Individual Hand Pieced and Hand Quilted

1100 A majority of the quilt must be hand pieced, and it must be **ALL** hand quilted (no machine quilting) by same person. The quilt is to be no larger than 110" x 110".

Individual Machine Pieced and Hand Quilted

1200 A majority of the quilt must be machine pieced, and it must be **ALL** hand quilted (no machine quilting) by same person. The quilt is to be no larger than 110" x 110".

Individual Machine Pieced and Machine Quilted

A majority of the quilt is machine pieced, and it is machine quilted by the same person. Select the appropriate size category.

2000 Small – The total of all sides is to be less than 180".

2100 Medium – The total of all sides should be greater than 180" but less than 288". (Examples: lap quilts, baby quilts, wall hangings)

2200 Large – The quilt is to be no larger than 110" x 110".

Individual Hand Appliqué

3100 Individual Hand Appliqué and Hand Quilted – The quilt is to be hand appliquéd and hand quilted by same person. More than 50% of the quilt must be hand appliquéd, and the quilt is to be no larger than 110" x 110".

3200 Individual Hand Appliqué and Machine Quilted – The quilt is to be hand appliquéd and machine quilted by same person. More than 50% of the quilt must be hand appliquéd, and the quilt is to be no larger than 110" x 110".

Individual Machine Appliqué – Hand or Machine Quilted

The quilt is to be machine appliquéd and quilted (either by hand or machine) by the same person. More than 50% of the quilt must be machine appliquéd.

4000 Small – The total of all sides is to be less than 180".

4100 Medium – The total of all sides should be greater than 180" but less than 288".

4200 Large – The quilt is to be no larger than 110" x 110".

Collaborative Machine Pieced and Machine Quilted

A majority of the quilt is machine pieced, and it is machine quilted. The quilt is the combined effort of two (2) or more people. Select the appropriate size category.

5000 Small – The total of all sides is to be less than 180”.

5100 Medium – The total of all sides should be greater than 180” but less than 288”. (Examples: lap quilts, baby quilts, wall hangings)

5200 Large – The quilt is to be no larger than 110” x 110”.

Collaborative Hand Appliqué

6000 The quilt is to be more than 50% hand appliquéd, and it may be either hand or machine quilted. The quilt is the combined effort of two (2) or more people, and the quilt is to be no larger than 110” x 110”.

Collaborative Machine Appliqué

6100 The quilt is to be more than 50% machine appliquéd, and it may be either hand or machine quilted. The quilt is the combined effort of two (2) or more people, and the quilt is to be no larger than 110” x 110”.

Art Quilts

7000 Pictorial – This quilt depicts a recognizable person, animal, plant, place (landscape, cityscape, etc.), or object. The quilt is to be no larger than 110” x 110”.

7100 Innovative – This quilt is an original design or original interpretation of a design, without any recognizable shape or pattern. (i.e., see Pictorial category above). It shall not be a copy of an existing work or a commercial pattern. The quilt is to be no larger than 110” x 110”.

7200 Miniatures – All aspects of this quilt must be a scaled down version of a large quilt design, and the total of *all* sides is to be 96” or less.

Other Techniques

8000 This category will include quilts that embrace special techniques such as yo-yo, crazy quilt, cathedral window, whole cloth, heavily embellished, embroidered, painted, or stenciled. The quilt can be no larger than 110” x 110”

Kits

9000 The quilt in this category was purchased as a pre-assembled kit that included pattern, fabric, and/or other necessary materials. (Examples: wall hangings, block-of-the month programs) Quilts made from kits that include pre-cut pieces are not eligible to be entered.
